


Summer Splash Day

Hurricane Preparedness - Be Ready Before The Storm

Hurricane season runs June 1 to November 30 every year. Hurricanes can bring severe winds, heavy rainfall, storm surge, coastal and inland flooding, rip currents, tornadoes, and even landslides.

Before June 1st, prepare for storms by <u>finding</u> <u>your evacuation zone</u>, deciding where to shelter, <u>building your disaster supply kit</u>, and strengthening your home (DO NOT tape your windows). Visit the <u>HurricaneStrong</u> website and use the checklists to complete your plan today.

During a hurricane it is critical to stay safe and put your <u>disaster preparedness plan</u> into action.

Take all safety precautions, <u>monitor the storm</u>, and follow the advice of authorities, especially if they order evacuations. If you don't evacuate, stay indoors and shelter in an interior, windowless room during high winds.

Lastly, after a hurricane downed power lines, contaminated water, and flooded roadways create hazardous conditions. Stay indoors until authorities say it's safe to leave or return home and <u>Use generators safely</u> during power outages.
